

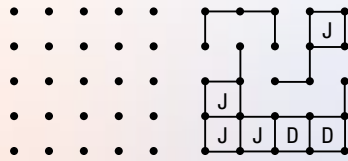

Dots and boxes

This game for two players is trickier than it seems at first sight. Mark 5 rows of 5 dots on a piece of paper to form these squares. Players take turns to join two of the dots with a straight line. 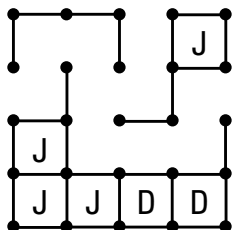
